

# Woolen Oak Mystery Stitch-A-Long

Finished Size: 16" Square

This applique pattern is intended for use with the Woolen Oak background block. Background fabric requirements are included on the Background Block Pattern you will find included.

## Supplies Needed:

### Wool—

- 5" X 6" neutral (sheep)
- 2" X 2 1/2" brown (acorn caps)
- 2" X 4" tan plaid (acorns)
- 3" X 3" Red (sheep head & legs)
- 2 1/2" X 8" green (grass)
- 4" X 4" gold (2 leaves)
- 7 1/2" X 13" fall leaves (2 large & 4 small leaves)

### Other—


- Paper backed fusible
- valdani perle cotton—size 12 (Orange O510)
- valdani perle cotton—size 12 (Golden Brown P12)

## Wool appliqué


1. Trace appliqué shapes on paper side of fusible,
2. Cut roughly around shapes. Fuse shapes to wools.
3. Cut shapes out of wool on drawn lines.
4. Remove paper backing from all shapes, position on cotton background, fuse.
5. Using Valdani perle cotton, blanket stitch outer edges of all the shapes.
6. Using a chalk marker draw curly vines.
7. Using 2 strands of Valdani Chain stitch the curly vines.
8. Add French knots for bittersweet.
9. Stem stitch veins on leaves.

Enjoy Block #8 along with the other 11 blocks of the Woolen Oak Mystery Stitch-A-Long.




## Blanket Stitch










## French Knot
