

Potted Petals Mystery Stitch-A-Long

Finished Size: 12" Square

This applique pattern is intended for use with the Potted Petals Project sponsored by Calico Patch Designs & Woolie Friends.

Supplies Needed:

Wool—

- 7" X 7" grey (water can)
- 4" x 4" lt. grey (sprinkler head and shovel)
- 2" x 4" tan (shovel handle)
- 5 1/2" X 5 1/2" terra cotta (clay pots)
- 6" X 6" striped green (long leaves)
- 2" X 7" green (stems and small leaves)
- 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" light orange (blooms)
- 4" x 5" medium orange (blooms)
- 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" dark orange (blooms)
- 4" x 4" light mauve (blooms)
- 4" x 4" burgundy (blooms)

Cotton—

14" x 14" dark homespun

Other—

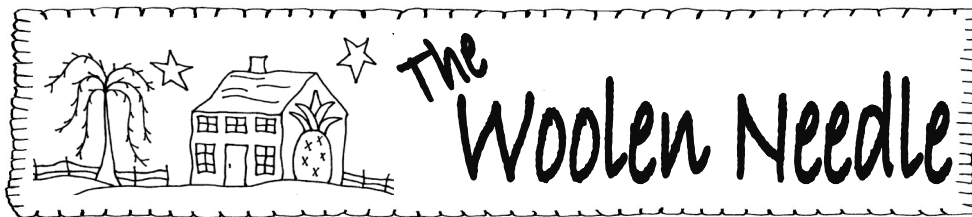
- Paper backed fusible
- valdani perle cotton— M7 (fall leaves)
- valdani perle cotton— M90, O547 or O513 (chocolate browns)
- valdani perle cotton— H204 (nostalgic rose)
- valdani perle cotton— O126 (old cottage grey)
- valdani perle cotton-- O575, O519 or H202 (green)

Finished Size: 12" square

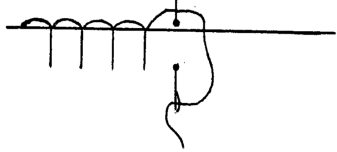

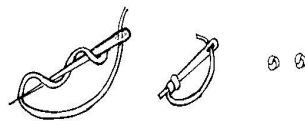

Wool Tips: When applying fusible products to wool use a dry iron. When fusing wool to wool we use steam and light contact of the iron to the wool to prevent scorching. Place all traced shapes on your wool before fusing to make sure they fit.

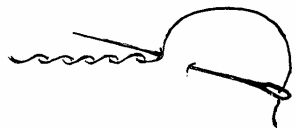
Blanket Stitch



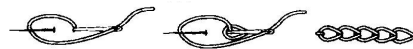
French Knot



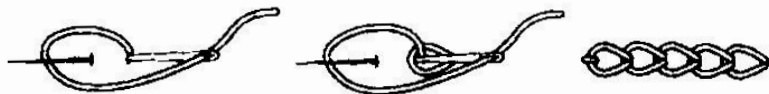
Stem Stitch

Wool appliqué

1. Trace appliqué shapes on paper side of fusible,
2. Cut roughly around shapes. Fuse shapes to wools.
3. Cut shapes out of wool on drawn lines.
4. Following the **Wool Tips**, fuse the water can, clay pots, shovel, handle and long leaves. (**See the special technique for the leaves below**).
5. Using Valdani perle cotton thread, stitch as suggested in the **Stitching Chart**.
6. Arrange flowers, small leaves and stems, fuse and stitch.
7. Add long stitch stamens with a French knot at flower centers
8. Press and trim block to 12 1/2" square.

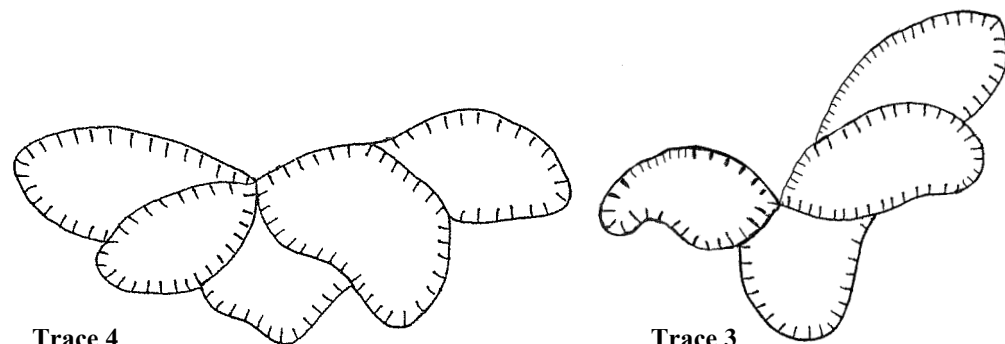
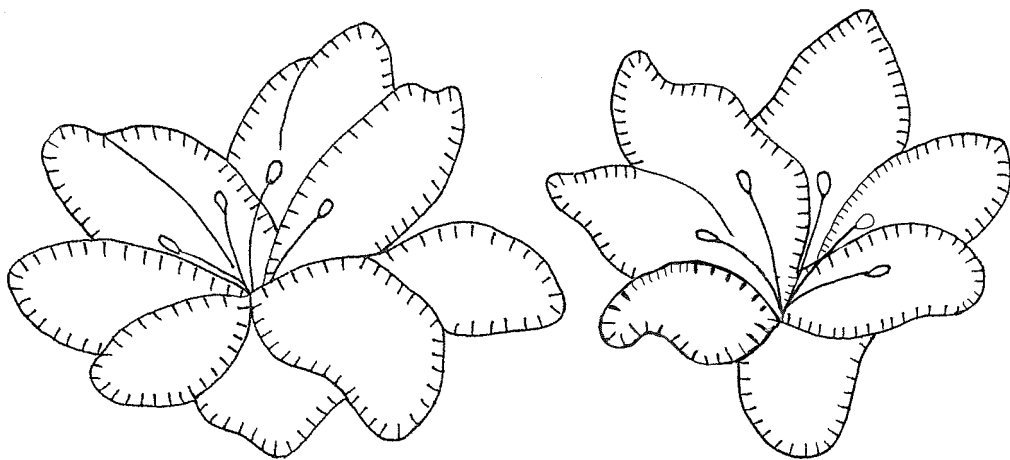
Leaf technique:

I left the fusible off 1" of the tip of the leaves so the leaf could fold forward for dimension. Blanket stitch along the leaf, continuing around the tip of the leaf that is not fused down and continuing along the fused edge.

Valdani	Size of your choice, I used size #12
O126	Blanket Stitch - watering can Chain Stitch - accent lines on the watering can French Knot - water holes on the spout
M90, O547 or O513	Blanket Stitch - clay pots and shovel handle Chain Stitch - accent lines on the clay pots
O575, O519 or H202	Blanket Stitch - leaves
M7	Blanket Stitch - flowers
H204	Blanket Stitch - flowers

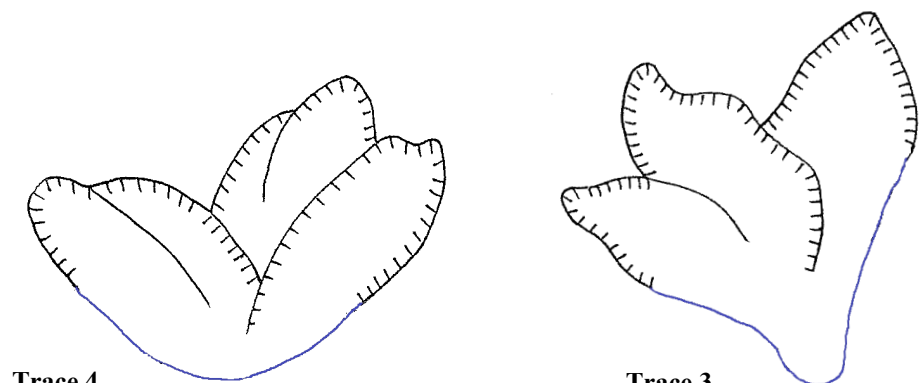

Shapes have been reversed for fusible appliqué method.



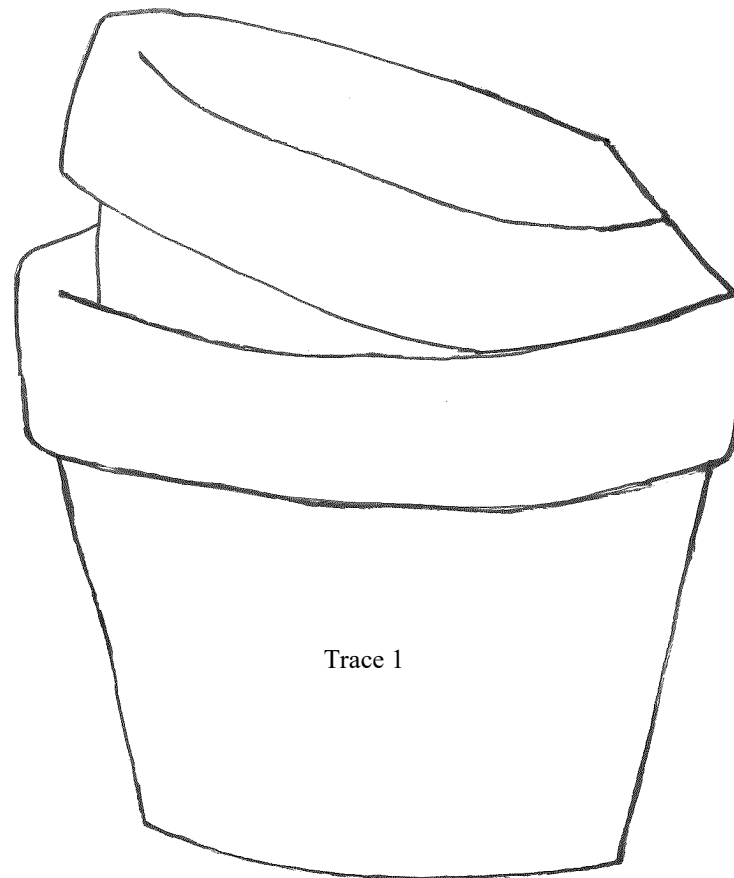
Trace 4
1 medium orange, 2 dark orange, 1 burgundy

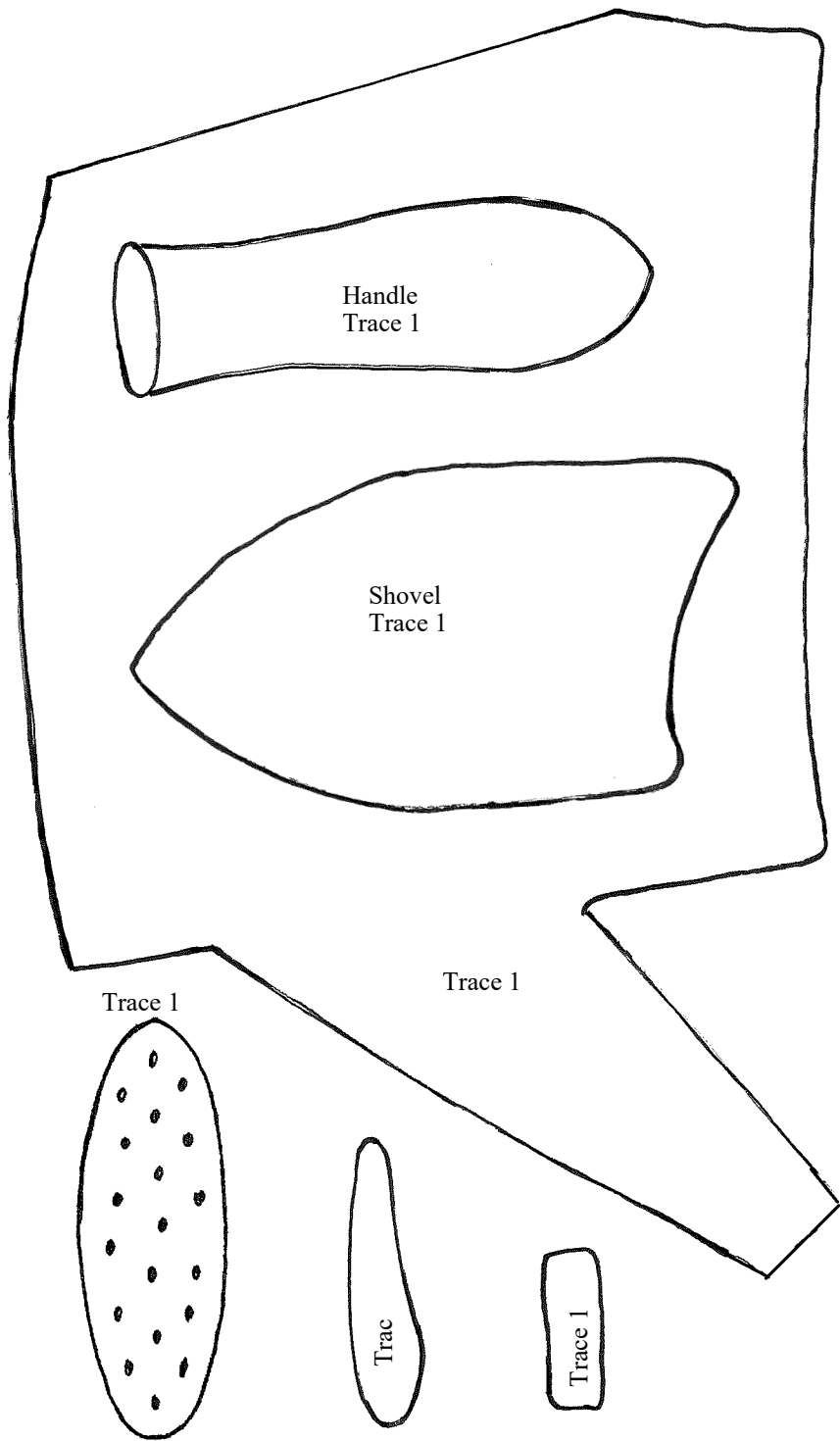
Trace 3
1 light orange, 2 burgundy



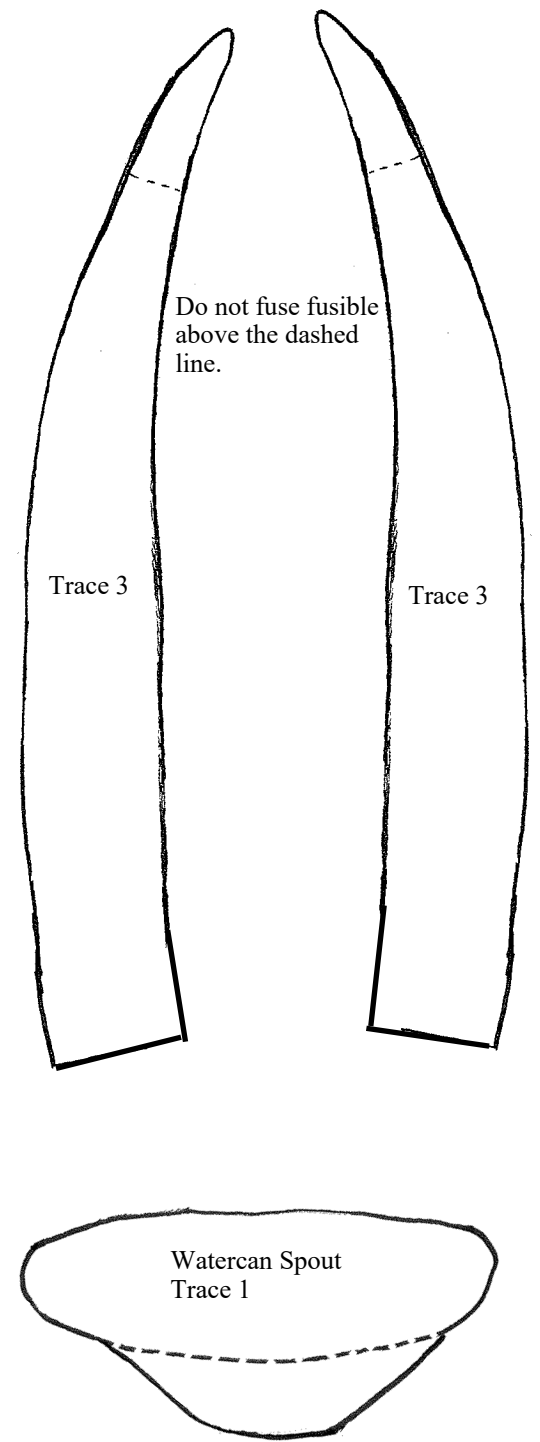
Trace 4

Fuse a 1" x 7" piece of fusible to the darker green wool and cut 3 - 1/4" stems. You will subcut 2 of these into shorter segments to tuck under and between flowers.



Appliqué Layout Diagram:
