Potted Petals Mystery Stitch-A-Long

Fíníshed Síze: 12" Square

This applique pattern is intended for use with the Potted Petals Project sponsored by Calico Patch Designs & Woolie Friends.

Supplies Needed:

Wool-

- チ" X チ" grey (water can)
- 4" x 4" lt. grey (sprinkler head and shovel)
- 2" x 4" tan (shovel handle)
- 51/2" X 51/2" terra cotta (clay pots)
- 6" X 6" striped green (long leaves)
- 2" X 7" green (stems and small leaves)
- 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" light orange (blooms)
- 4" x 5" medium orange (blooms)
- 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" dark orange (blooms)
- 4" x 4" light mauve (blooms)
- · 4" x 4" burgundy (blooms)

Cotton-

14" x 14" dark homespun

Other-

- · Paper backed fusible
- Valdaní perle cotton— M7 (fall leaves)
- Valdaní perle cotton— M90, 0547 or 0513 (chocolate browns)
- Valdaní perle cotton— H204 (nostalgíc rose)
- Valdaní perle cotton— 0126 (old cottage grey)
- Valdaní perle cotton-- 0575, 0519 or H202 (green)

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Potted Petals Block 6

Finished Size: 12" square



Wool Tips: When applying fusible products to wool use a dry iron. When fusing wool to wool we use steam and light contact of the iron to the wool to prevent scorching. Place all traced shapes on your wool before fusing to make sure they fit.



Wool appliqué

- 1. Trace appliqué shapes on paper side of fusible,
- 2. Cut roughly around shapes. Fuse shapes to wools.
- 3. Cut shapes out of wool on drawn lines.
- 4. Following the **wool Tips**, fuse the water can, clay pots, shovel, handle and long leaves. (See the special technique for the leaves below).
- 5. Using Valdani perle cotton thread, stitch as suggested in the **Stitching Chart**.
- 6. Arrange flowers, small leaves and stems, fuse and stitch.
- 7. Add long stitch stamens with a French knot at flower centers
- 8. Press and trim block to 12 1/2" square.

Leaf technique:

I left the fusible off 1" of the tip of the leaves so the leaf could fold forward for dimension. Blanket stitch along the leaf, continuing around the tip of the leaf that is not fused down and continuing along the fused edge.
