Happy Easter is a fun mat to stitch for the holiday. 8" x 11"

Supplies:

- 5" x 5" pínk
- 5" x 5" green
- 81/2" x 11" dark teal
- 9" x 12" neutral background
- 10" x 12" cotton back
- Valdaní síze 8 M14 pínk, 0551
 yellow, P4 líght neutral
- Valdaní síze 12 0559 green

The Woolen Needle



- Trace all the pattern pieces, as indicated on the pattern page, on the paper side of fusible web. The pattern has already been reversed for you. Be sure to trace on the dotted lines.
- Cut out shapes roughly 1/8" outside of the drawn lines.
- Fuse the shapes to the appropriate wools, referring to the photo.
- Cut the wool shapes out on the line for perfect shapes. Remove the paper backing.
- Please notice, the dotted lines indicate where the shape is tucked under another shape.
- Stitch flowers with 3 double strand French knots in the center, Lazy Daisie stitches on the flower petals.
- Fly stitch on the leaves adding a Backstitch down the stems.
- I used a coordinating machine thread to Whip stitch the lettering and oval of the egg.
- Cut a 9" x 12" piece of fusible web and fuse to the back of your project. Remove the paper and fuse on the cotton back.
- Square up your project, and Blanket stitch edge. ENJOY!

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
