# Picking Tulips

Fíníshed Síze: 12" Square

The Woolie Friends have been in the Spring Spirit. Our Dancing Tulips Stitch A Long is a breath of fresh spring inspiration.

### Supplies Needed:

#### Wool-

- 6" X 6" dark pink (tulips)
- 4" x 6" light pink (tulips)
- 4" x 4" green (leaves)
- 3" x 3" purple (small blooms)

#### Cotton-

- 1/2 yard neutral homespun (background)
- 5/8 yard backing and binding (optional)

#### Threads-

Eleganza Perle Cotton

- · 212 honey cake
- 1003 fuchsía
- 1055 ball Pít
- 2232 earthy brown

Valdaní Perle Cotton

· P2 - olive green

## Helpful Items-

- Heat N Bond Light Paper backed fusible
- · Chalk Marker

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
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# Instructions:

- Cut a 13" square from the neutral homespun
- Trace appliqué shapes on paper side of fusible
- Cut roughly around shapes
- Fuse shapes to wool and cut out on the shapes the traced line.
- · Arrange applique in place overlapping where necessary.
- Fuse applique to your background block.
- Using a chalk marker draw curvy vines & petal lines on tulips.
- Using perle cotton thread, stitch as suggested in the Stitching Chart.
- Press and trim your block to 12 1/2" square.
- Your block is ready to add to the Woolie Friends Dancing Tulip project or you can back and bind it if you choose to make this a stand alone project.

valdaní	
212	French Knots - center of small blooms
1003	Lazy Daisy Stitch - small blooms extending the stitch outside of the bloom to give the bloom a star shape
1055	Blanket Stítch - tulíps Chain Stítch - petal line on tulíps
2232	Chain Stitch - Vines
Valdaní P2	Blanket Stitch - leaves Chain Stitch - tulip stem

Shapes have been reversed for fusible appliqué.
