# Glory Days

The Woolie Friends have been in the Patriotic mood most recently to bring you a great Flag themed project.

## Supplies Needed:

#### Wool:

- 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" neutral texture (sheep)
- 2" x 8" red (flag & penny)
- 3" x 3" blue (flag & penny)
- 2" x 2" neutral (penny)
- 3" x 3" brown (head, tail & feet)
- 2 1/2" x 4" gold (flowers)
- 2" x 2" green (leaves)
- 1/8 yd blue background (optional)
- 2 1/2" x 4" red scallop pennies (optional)
- 4" x 5" neutral texture scallop pennies (optional)

#### Cotton:

1/3 yard — neutral flannel (background) 1/3 yd. — backing (optional)

#### Threads:

Eleganza 100% Egyptían 8 wt. Perle Cotton:

- 06 first snow
- 1009 heart beat
- · 2228 pine green
- 2233 tarníshed Black or 2232 earthy brown
- 724 twilight hour (optional)

### Helpful Items:

- Heat N Bond Light Paper backed fusible
- · Chalk Marker
- Star Buttons (optional)

## Instructions:


- Cut a 9 1/2" x 11 1/2" background block.
- Center § Chalk a  $81/2" \times 101/2"$  reference rectangle on the cotton block for placement boundaries.
- Trace appliqué shapes on paper side of fusible.
- · Cut roughly around shapes.
- Fuse shapes to wool and cut out the shapes.
- · Arrange all shapes on the background.
- · Fuse applique to your background block.
- Following the Stitching Chart stitch wool applique shapes.
- Chalk (I prefer to use a pencil) the flag pole, flower stems & grass lines to stitch.
- Trím your block to 8 1/2" x 10 1/2"
- Your block is ready to add to the Woolie Friends project or you can continue with the Optional Instructions to make this a stand alone project.

## Optional Instructions:


- Turn under 1/2" on all sides of the block and press.
- Cut the blue background to 10"  $\times$  12  $^{1/2}$ "
- Position the applique block on the blue background wool 1" from the top  $\mathcal E$  side edges.
- · Stitch the running stitch to secure the block in place
- Space 1/2" below the applique block 5-11/2 neutral pennies 55-1" red pennies.
- Blanket stitch the pennies.
- Fuse paper backed fusible to the back side of the blue background wool.
- Fuse to cotton backing.
- Trim edges 1/2" to 3/4" outside of the applique block, continuing around the pennies to create a scalloped edge along the bottom.
- Blanket stitch the outer edge.
- Attach star buttons.

Eleganza	Stitching Chart
06	Fly Stítch - white lines on flag (shorten stítch length) Straight Stítch - stars on flag
724	Blanket Stitch - outer edge (optional)
1009	Blanket Stitch - flag & pennies on sheep (scalloped pennies / optional) Running Stitch - around block (optional)
2228	Stem Stitch - flower stems & grass lines Running Stitch - center of leaves
2233 or 2232	Chain Stitch - flag pole & flower centers Blanket Stitch - sheep & around flowers French Knot - sheep's eyes






Fly Stitch
