

Frostbite Farm

The Woolie Friends have had cold and snow, so we thought a wintery farm scene would be a great block to feature snowmen & barn quilts.

Supplies Needed:

Wool—

- 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" red (barn)
- 1 1/2" x 4" black (barn roof trim)
- 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" charcoal gray (chimney)
- 3" x 10" tan (path)
- 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" neutral texture (snowman)
- 3" x 3" black (hat)
- 2" x 2" blue (scarf)
- 1" x 1" orange (carrot nose)
- 6" x 7" green plaid (trees)

Cotton—

3/8 yard - black mottled flannel (background)

1/4 yard - aged muslin (ground snow)

5/8 yard - backing, border and binding (optional)

Threads—

Eleganza 100% Cotton

720 - Imperial Banner

- 1037 - Shield Bearer
- 2228 - Pine Green
- 2232 - Earthy Brown
- Black

Helpful Items—

- Heat N Bond Light - Paper backed fusible



Frostbite Farm

Finished Size: 12" Square



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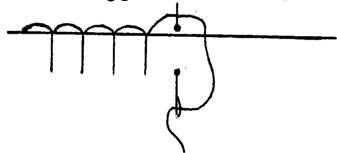
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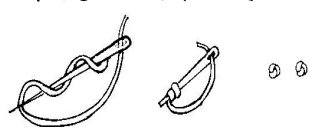
Instructions:

- Cut a 13" square from the black flannel.
- Trace appliqué shapes on paper side of fusible.
- Cut roughly around shapes.
- Fuse shapes to wool and cut out the shapes on traced lines.
- Arrange appliqué in place overlapping where necessary. (Check out the video on our face book page showing the use of the Appli-Fuse Mat for placement of wool appliqué pieces)
- Fuse appliqué shapes to your background block. Keep in mind the block will be trimmed to 12 1/2" square after you complete your stitching.
- Using perle cotton thread, stitch as suggested in the Stitching Chart.
- Press and trim your block to 12 1/2" square.
- Your block is ready to add to the Woolie Friends - Frostbite Farm project or you can add a border, back and bind it if you choose to make this a stand alone project.

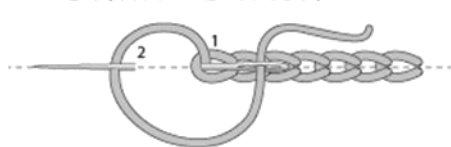

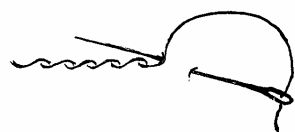
French Knot



Chain Stitch

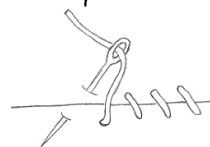


Stem Stitch

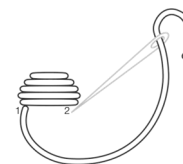

720	Chain Stitch - hat brim Stem Stitch - accent lines on the scarf Satin Stitch - barn quilt
1037	Blanket Stitch - snowman & path Chain Stitch - ground snow swirls Satin Stitch - barn quilt Straight Stitch - snowflakes
2228	Blanket Stitch - trees Chain Stitch - barn quilt
2232	Chain Stitch - pitchfork handle Stem Stitch - tines on pitchfork & snowman branches Satin Stitch - barn quilt
Black	Blanket Stitch - barn side walls, bottom edge & roof Chain Stitch - door, windows & horizontal line Back Stitch - hard lines on the barn quilt & chimney French Knot Stitch - snowman mouth & buttons Satin Stitch - eyes & buttons Stem Stitch - around the snowman for definition
<u>Sewing thread</u> Orange	Whip Stitch - carrot nose

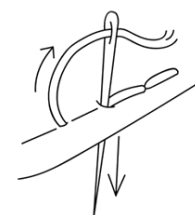
Whip Stitch



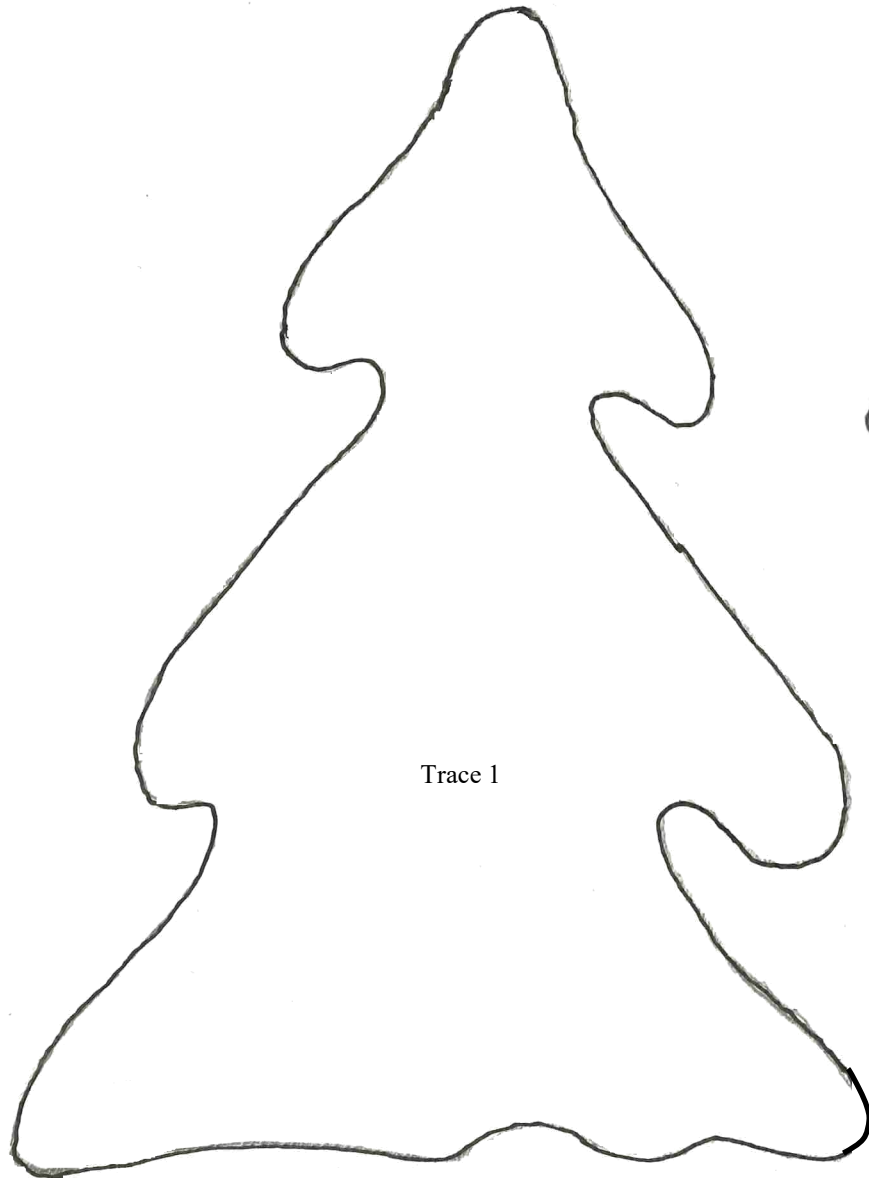
Satin Stitch



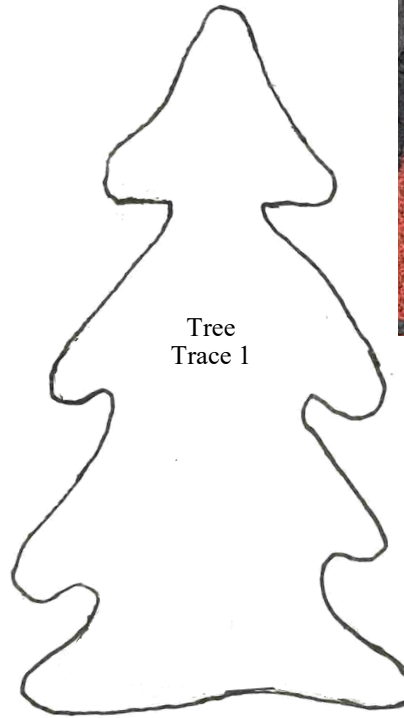
Back Stitch



Shapes have been reversed for fusible appliqué hod.



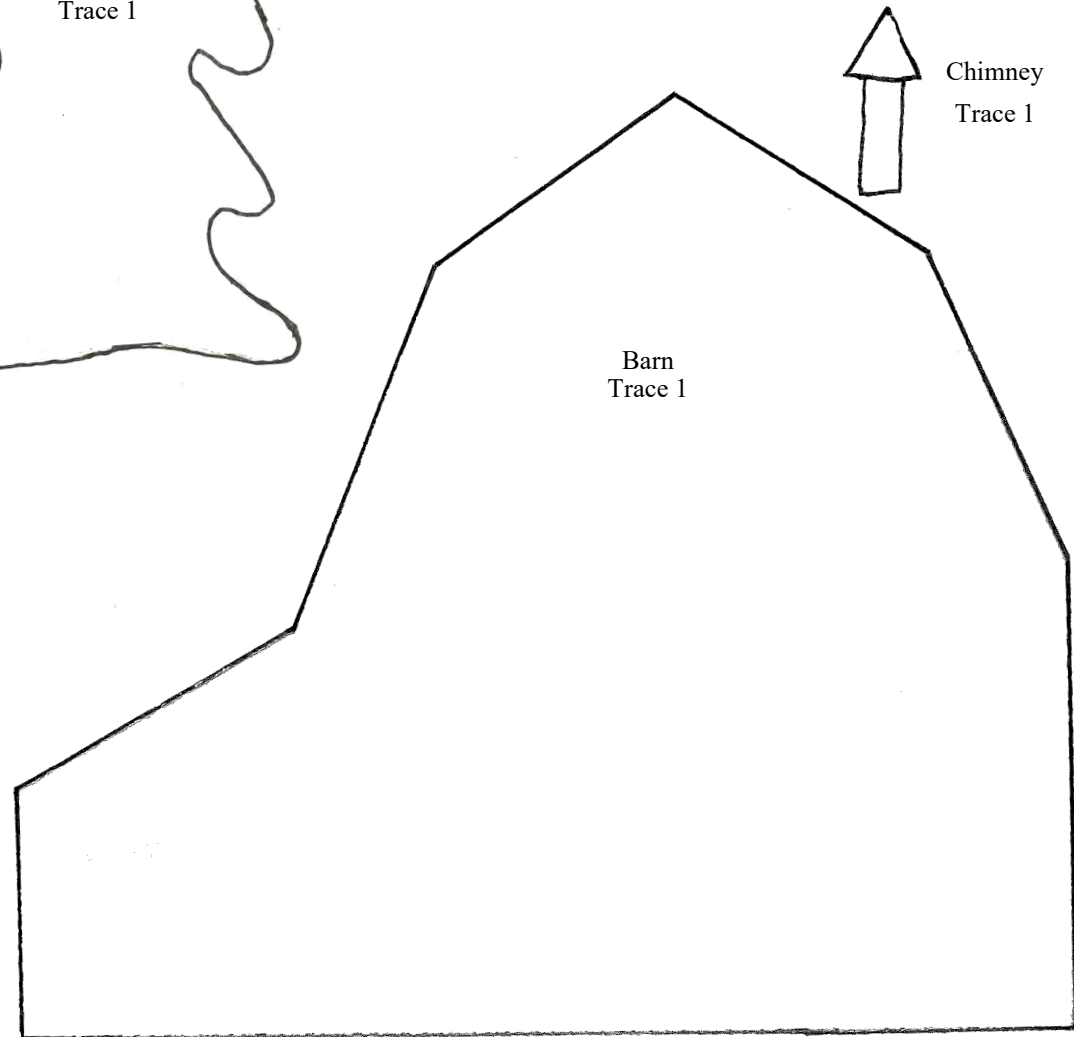

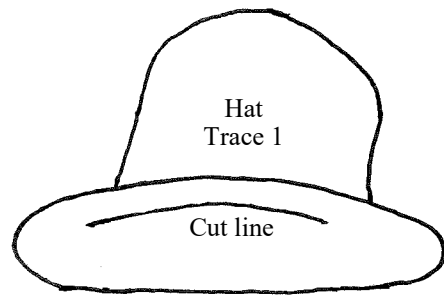
Trace the barn quilt on tear away stabilizer. Back Stitch the black hard lines through the paper. Gently tear the paper away and continue to stitch the barn quilt. Included in kit.



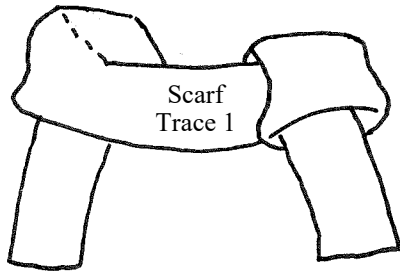

Shapes have been reversed for fusible appliqué.



*The cut line lets you tuck the snowman's head up in to the hat. You may have to lengthen the cut a bit.



Add straight stitches to the tails of the scarf to look like fringe.
